 { A sofa is more comfortable than a chair. (用最高級合併)
 → A sofa is the most comfortable (of the three.)
 3. { Lisa is five years old.
 { Mary is seven years old. (用 younger 合併)
 → Lisa is younger than Mary.
 4. { David is younger than Ben.
 { Ben is younger than Mary. (用 youngest 合併)
 → David is the youngest (of the three.)
 5. { Lisa's jacket costs \$200.
 { David's jacket costs \$500. (用 more expensive 合併)
 → David's jacket is more expensive than Lisa's jacket.
